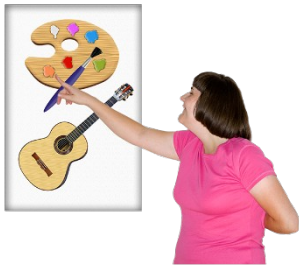

About ausland and what we do

ausland

ausland is an arts venue in Berlin for

- music
- film
- literature
- dance
- performances
- sound art.



At ausland we give **grants** to small groups of dancers and performers to help them make a new dance or performance.



A **grant** is money or support that you do not have to pay back.



If you get a grant we will ask you to share your new dance or performance with others.

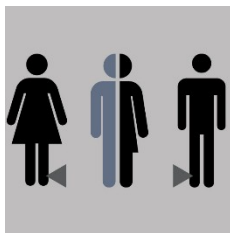
It is up to your group how you do this.



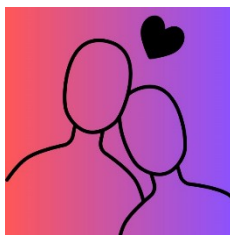
We are looking for projects which are curious and **queer feminist**.



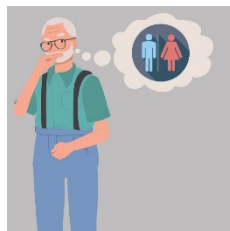
Queer is what some people call themselves if they feel that other words to describe **gender** and **sexual orientation** are not right for them.



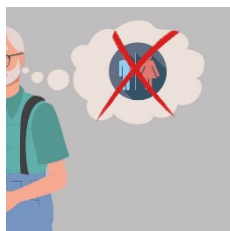
- Your **gender** is whether you are man, woman or neither.



- Your **sexual orientation** is who you are attracted to. Like bisexual, lesbian, gay and straight.



Many people think there are only male and female genders. And that there are things that women must do. Like have children.



Queer feminists do not agree. Queer feminists support people of any gender and sexual orientation to have the same rights as other people.

What your group can do with the grant



The grant is for groups of 3 to 5 people to create a dance or performance.



The grant supports each group for 1 month to do

- 1 week of research



- 2 weeks of **rehearsal** at ausland
Rehearsal means practicing.



- a show or presentation of your work



- 1 week to think about how it went.
Like what went well and what you would change.

Who can apply for our grant



Our grant is open to everyone.

But we want to give grants to people who have not had a grant before, maybe because of **discrimination**.



Discrimination means treating someone worse than other people for some reason.

For example, because of someone's race, disability, or sexual orientation.



We want to help make art more **inclusive** so everyone can take part.

We welcome projects that are open to new ideas and that are inclusive.



You must be registered in Berlin to apply for this grant.



University students cannot apply for this grant.

What you get with the grant



We will give you

- 2000 euros for each person in the group



- Space at ausland to work together on your project.



- Technology to use like lights and cameras.
We can help you use these too.



- Help with any questions you have about performing or finding the right people to work with.

Accessibility at ausland
